WHAT'S NEW FOR '88

Reliant, a front-drive compact that's identical to the Dodge Aries, is available in only one price series for 1988 with fewer options to choose from as Chrysler simplifies its Kcar lines and gives them the "America" treatment that proved successful on the Dodge Omni/Plymouth Horizon subcompacts. Base prices have been cut by nearly \$1300, individual options have been reduced and more optional equipment is available only in option packages. Last year's base series is gone, leaving only the LE series for the 2- and 4-door sedans and 5-door station wagon. The only significant mechanical change for 1988 is that an electronic lockup torque converter now comes on the 3-speed automatic transmission with either the standard 2.2-liter 4-cylinder engine or optional 2.5-liter four. Last year, the lockup torque converter, which is supposed to improve fuel economy by reducing slippage between the engine and transmission, came only with the 2.5 engine. A 5-speed manual transmission is standard with the 2.2. The automatic is optional with the 2.2 and required with the 2.5.

SUMMARY

Chrysler is trying to use the same magic on the K-cars that rejuvenated sales of the Omni/Horizon twins. They've certainly got us interested with a base price of \$6995. Assuming you want more than a stripped sedan, how about around \$9000 for a Reliant with the 2.5-liter engine, automatic, air conditioning, a stereo and few other extras? That's cheaper than many subcompacts, plus you get Chrysler's 7-year warranties on the powertrain and rust. The K-cars have been designed for basic family transportation since they were introduced seven years ago, so don't expect a compact luxury sedan or a BMW-beater for \$9000. In fact, don't expect a car that beats the Honda Accord either, except in price. In these days of \$15,000-16,000 Accords and Toyota Camrys, it's refreshing to see a fullyequipped compact for less than \$10,000. We recommend the 2.5-liter engine as the best choice. The 2.5 has better performance and less noise than the standard 2.2-liter engine, and still returns reasonable fuel economy. The interior is large enough to hold four adults with room to spare (if you stick with the standard front bucket seats) and the trunk has adequate cargo space. The K-car wagons have decent cargo space for this class. Chrysler's come up with another low-priced car that should appeal to valueconscious shoppers.
